

Sherborne Museum 200 Club Rules

1. The Museum has been issued with a Small Societies Lottery licence and the Club will be run in accordance with the Small Societies Lottery legislation as specified in the 2005 Gambling Act.
2. The Promoter of the 200 Club is Judy Nash of Padarn, Coles Lane, Yetminster, Sherborne, Dorset, DT9 6LP.
3. The object of the club is to raise funds for the running of Sherborne Museum. Half of the money raised by the club annually will be put to this use and the other half will be returned in cash prizes.
4. Each participant must be over the age of 16.
5. The club shall be administered by a committee of museum staff, one of whom will be appointed treasurer to take charge of the club account and payment of prizes.
6. There will be a separate bank account specifically for the club money audited annually.
7. The decision of the committee regarding any matters requiring adjudication shall be final.
8. Subscription to the club will cost £12 per year, payable by banker's order, and participants may have more than one subscription. One-off payments of £12 are also acceptable.
9. Each subscription will be allocated a roll number and a record of these against participants' details will be maintained. Participants will be notified of their allocated roll number(s).
10. Draws will take place quarterly and there will be a first, second and third cash prize. The draws will take place on the first Tuesday in February, May, August and November.
11. To enable membership to fluctuate and to ensure that the ratio of prize money to allocated roll numbers is maintained, 1st prize will be half of the total amount of allocated prize money for that quarter, 2nd will be a third and 3rd will be a sixth.
12. Prize winners will be notified in writing or by e-mail where appropriate and payment will be made by cheque sent to the address specified by the winning participant.
13. The results of each draw will be published in a local publication, the museum newsletter and displayed in the museum.
14. The club will be run on an annual basis but membership can be taken out at any time. Admission to the draw will commence in the quarter following receipt of the subscription.
